MINUTES OF TREE AUTHORITY HELD ON 30.08.2023 AT 3:00 PM UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF PRINCIPAL SECRETARY (E&F) CUM CHAIRMAN OF THE TREE AUTHORITY, GOVT. OF NCT OF DELHI-REG.

As mandated under section 7 of Delhi Preservation of Trees Act, 1994(DPTA, 1994) and in compliance of the Order dated 31.07.2023 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in WPC No. 7253/2023, a meeting of Tree Authority was convened on 30.08.2023 at 3:00 PM under the chairmanship of Principal Secretary (Environment & Forests), Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

The following members/invitees were present in the meeting:-

Chairman of the Tree Authority welcomed all the members and Member Secretary placed the agenda items of the meeting before the Authority. The deliberations and decisions taken on each Agenda Item are as below:-

• Agenda item No. 1:- Progress on Green Action Plan 2023.

Member Secretary of the Tree Authoritypresented the details on plantation under Green Action Plan since last meeting:

2023 up to August, 2023.	52.59	36.20

The details are attached herewith.

Tree authority was also informed about increase of Green Cover in Delhi as per ISFR of FSI in 2021 from 21.87 % in 2019 to 23.06 % in 2021.

• Agenda item No. 2:- Tree Transplantation study

Member Secretary of the Tree Authority informed that the report of survival rate of transplanted trees is awaited from Forest Research Institute (FRI), Dehradun. However, an internal committee i.e Tree Transplantation Monitoring Committee was constituted by the Hon'ble Minister (E&F), Govt. of NCT of Delhi. The Tree Authority was of the view that the



success of Transplantation can only be evaluated after completion of minimum of 2 consecutive summer and winter seasons. However, as per the assessment of implementation &effectiveness of the Delhi Tree Transplantation policy, 2020, representative sites were taken across divisions andoverall survival rate of over 35% has been observed.

It was decided that to ensure better quality output at competitive costs, more transplantation agencies should be empaneled for carrying our transplantation in NCT of Delhi. The process of empanelment to be made totally online and given wide publicity.

• Agenda item No. 3:- Adoption of Trees.

Director (Hort.) MCD and Member of the Tree Authority informed that MCD has already operationalized an online portal for adoption of trees. It was decided that the Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD shall study and assess the tree adoption policy of MCD for extending it to the entire Delhi. The required proposal may be placed in next meeting.

• Agenda item No. 4:- Strengthening of Tree cell for functioning of Tree Authority

It was decided that the already existing Tree cell of Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD shall extend secretarial services to the Tree Authority. It was also decided to engage one One Senior Project Associate through ICSIL in State Budget after the approval of competent authority for analysing research proposals received, presenting research work submitted and undertaking research work in the Department.

• Agenda item No. 5:- Guidelines for identification of land for Compensatory Plantation.

Member Secretary of the Tree Authority informed that if the applicant has to take permission for felling / transplantation upto 10 trees, Forest department takes up plantation work in Land under its control. Tree authority noted the decision of Department.

It was also decided that Department shall accept proposals of eco-restoration as part of compensatory plantation after the approval of competent authority even though this may not result into any addition or increase in Green Cover/Forest cover in Delhi. To implement this, Department shall ask all land-owning agencies to identify lands for eco-restoration.

• Agenda item No. 6:- Guidelines for felling / pruning for government land and revision of existing guideline.

Member Secretary of the Tree Authority informed that the file of draft guidelines (Annexure-I) has been submitted to the Government for seeking approval under section-33 of Delhi Preservation of Trees (DPTA), 1994. The Main features of the draft guidelines:-

- Process of intimation under section-8 of DPTA, 1994.
- Process for application in case of trees standing on govt. Land.
- Reduction in processing time
- Process of disposal of timber.
- Provision for training.



It was decided that the timeline for disposal upon receiving the complete application should not be more than 15 working days for improving both Ease of Living and Ease of doing business. All required policy, trainings, manpower and infrastructures may be put in place before next meeting of Tree Authority.

• Agenda item No. 7:- Monitoring of Compliances against permission granted.

Member Secretary of the Tree Authorityinformed that DPTA e-forest Portal is enabled to receive compliances online from all users. Tree authority directed to undertake training of applicants as per requirement and enhance the compliance submission on portal.

Further, to enforce monitoring of compliances, Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD shall maintain the status of compliances against permission granted for felling / transplantation of treesand present the same in the regular quarterly meetings of the Tree Authority.

• Agenda item No. 8:- Undertaking awareness program about provisions of DPTA, 1994.

Member Secretary of the Tree Authority informed that Department of Forests and Wildlife, GNCTD has developed a portal for training all stakeholders on Delhi Preservation of Trees Act (DPTA), 1994.

It was decided that following the tutorial videos are to be placed on portal on:

- Provisions of DPTA, 1994 in English and Hindi.
- How to get approval for felling of trees?
- How to judge a tree dangerous and action to be taken thereafter?
- How to react if threat to a tree or damage to tree is detected?

It was also decided that the Training cell of Department will identify best practices around the world on Nursery technology, Avenue plantation, Tree management and Tree Transplantation and curate training programs for Executive Staffs to get exposure at early stage in their careers and contribute effectively.

• Agenda item No. 9:- Inviting universities for undertaking critical study of the proposals of development approved till date.

Member Secretary of the Tree Authority informed the as per article of 7(g)-

"Duties of Tree Authority include undertaking critical study of the proposals of various government departments and private bodies for construction of buildings, roads, factories, irrigation works, laying out of electric, telephone, telegraph and other, transmission lines with regard to protection of existing trees and planting of more trees, wherever possible."

It was decided that Universities from India and abroad after the approval of competent authority will be invited to undertake critical study regarding-

- * Trees and matter incidental to their health for ensuring their ecological role.
- * Ways of reducing trees affected during planning of project.
- ❖ Identification of areas for plantation of trees.
- ❖ How to promote Agroforestry for Compensatory Plantation?



Department will ensure development of online mechanism for this and wide publicity among the colleges/Universities in and around Delhi.

• Agenda item No. 10:- Carrying out census of the existing trees

Member Secretary of the Tree Authority informed the following parameters have been identified for carrying out tree census of the existing trees:-

Tree ID No.	Height
Location-Road / Plot/ Garden	Girth at 30 cm from ground
Land Type-Pvt. /Govt.	Health of tree
GPS Coordinates	Photos- Tree, Bark, Leaf

It was decided that Tree census will be first done in all isolated patches and Green areas/city forest of Department of Forest and Wildlife and data to be presented in next meeting of Tree Authority.

• Other Items discussed with permission of chair:

It was decided that:

- ➤ Delhi Tree Preservation Rules, 1996 to be reviewed in view of experiences of operation in 27 years, new technologies, requirement of Ease of Living and Ease of Doing Business.
- ➤ All efforts to be made for infusing new technologies in management of Trees across Delhi
- ➤ Green Jobs required for Tree management to be identified and trainings to be organised accordingly.
- > Training cell to be strengthened.

The chairman insisted that the meeting should be held without fail in last week of third month as mandated in the DPTA, 1994. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
