Notice for Physical Standard Test, Walking Test, for the post of Forest Guard, Department of Forests & Wildlife, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

1. The candidates who are provisionally shortlisted on basis of the Computer Based Test (CBT) for the post of Forest Guard in the Department of Forests & Wildlife, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, as declared vide result notice no. F.No 1(39)/DCF(HQ)/Estt./Rect.-EdCIL/2019/12554-61 dated 28.03.2022 are now required to appear for Physical Standard Test and Walking Test.
2. **The Physical Standard Test and Walking Test for the post of Forest Guard is scheduled to be held on 23.12.2022 (as per admit card) at South Forest Division, Department of Forests & Wildlife, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, near Karni Singh Shooting Range, Tughlaqabad, New Delhi-110044.**
3. No candidate without Admit Card (issued by the Department), Photo identity card (Voter ID Card/ Aadhar Card/ Govt. ID/ Driving license) and two passport size photograph shall be allowed to enter the test venue.
4. Any kind of malpractices such as impersonation, canvassing, usage of steroids etc. shall invite penal action including rejection from present test as well as debarring from future examinations/tests.
5. The candidature to the Physical Standard Test and Walking Test is provisional and subject to the outcome of direction/decision/order, pronouncement of any Court of Law and mere issuance of Admit Card or appearance at the Test does not entitle the candidate to any claim for the post.
6. The Department reserves the right to cancel a part of or entire process of test due to administrative reasons and/or in case of unfair means, cheating or other irregularities/malpractices if noticed by the Department.
7. The Department reserves the right to reject the candidature of any ineligible candidate at any stage of recruitment/selection.

8. Request for postponement of the Physical Standard Test and Walking Test will not be entertained under any circumstances.
9. Any dispute with regard to this recruitment will be subject to courts/tribunals having jurisdiction over Delhi.
10. No TA/DA is admissible to any candidate for appearing in the test.
11. All the candidates are strictly advised to wear vest/T-Shirt for affixing chest badge for clear identification during Physical Standard Test and Walking Test.
12. The candidate should scrupulously follow the above instructions and also that of the designated officers of the Department at the Test Centre failing which the candidature of the candidate shall be cancelled.
13. Candidates are advised to visit the website of the Department regularly for further information and detailed instructions.
14. The details of Physical Standard Test and walking Test requirements are presented below:
- (a) The minimum standards for height and chest girth for a candidate shall be as follows:

	Height	Chest Girth

Female	150	79	05

However, the above height standards are relaxable to the extent given below in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes and Races such as Assamese, Bhutanese, Garhwali's, Gorkhas, Kumaonise, Ladakhese, Mizo, Naga, Nepalese, Sikkimese and those from Arunachal Pradesh, Lahaul and Spiti, Meghalaya

Male - 152 Cm

Female - 140 CM

- (b) Male/Female candidates must pass a Physical Test Covering a distance of 25/16 KMs respectively within four hours on foot.

15. Candidates, those who will qualifying in Physical Standard Test and Walking Test shall be called for Document Verification, schedule for which shall be notified separately.
