No. F.I.I.(40)/PA/DCF/96 (I)—In pursuance of the provisions of Section 4 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), read with State Ministry's notification No. 104-I dated 24-8-50 as amended by their Notification No. 146-I dated 6-12-50 (to Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi) hereby declares that it has been decided to constitute the lands mentioned in Schedule 'A' below as reserved Forest:

## SCHEDULE 'A'

All forest lands and wastelands which is the property of the government or over which government has proprietary rights in:

(Opposite Naukpara Gurudwara)  
surrounded on

North by Ring Road  
East by Road bifurcating from Ring Road separating Moti Bagh South and leading to Atma Sahib Temple and down to Pump House.

South by School and Kaliari Shop.  
West by "Block of Central Government Flats, Naukpara and further along leading to Ring Road Taxi Stand, Opposite Gurudwara.  
(area 17.5 acres)

No. F.I.I.(40)/PA/DCF/96 (II)—In pursuance of the provisions of clause (c) of sub-Section (1) of Section 4 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), read with State Ministry's notification No. 104-I dated 24-8-50 as amended by their notification No. 146-I dated 6-12-50, the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi hereby appoints the Additional District Magistrate (Revenue), Delhi, to be the Forest Settlement Officer to inquire in to and determine the existence, nature and extent of any right alleged to exist in favour of any person in or over any land comprised within such lands as notified via Notification No. F.I.I.(40)/PA/DCF/96 (I) dated 19th March, 1990 or in or over any forest produce and to deal with the same as provided in Chapter-II of the said Act:
