

ORDER

- To ensure to attend the NGT cases personally or by deputing a responsible official.
- Entire action has to be taken by concerned DCFs where the subject matter exclusively pertains to their division.
- In case the matter pertains to the entire department, they will take actions in respect of their divisions & inform the same to the Headquarters.
- To have detailed consultation with the advocates.
- DCF (P&M) will be responsible for compilation of reports of divisions in cases where department is to represent more than one division.
- Issue of BTF and appointment of advocate in the case will be additional responsibility of DCF (P&M).



No. FI(29)/PA/DC/95.—Whereas the Supreme Court of India in I.A.No. 18 and 22 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 4677/85 M.C. Mehta V/s Union of India & Others in their orders dated 25-1-96 and 13-3-96 have directed that uncultivated surplus land of Gaon Sabha falling in "Ridge" may be excluded from vesting in Gaon Sabha u/s 154 of the Delhi Land Reforms Act, 1954 and made available for the purpose of creation of Reserved Forest.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred u/s 154 of the Delhi Land Reforms Act, 1954 (8 of 1954), the Lt. Governor of National Capital Territory of Delhi, hereby declares the uncultivated land of Gaon Sabha specified in Column 'III' and Annexure 'A' to 'N' Annexed hereto, situated in Southern Ridge in respect of Villages mentioned in Column 'II' of table given below as surplus land and excludes the same from vesting in Gaon Sabha and further places the said land at the disposal of Forest Department of Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi.

क्रा.आ. 610(अ) — या: "दिल्ली रिज क्षेत्र," जो दिल्ली में भारत की नई राजधानी स्थापित करने हेतु भारत सरकार द्वारा दिनांक 21-12-1911 के माध्यम से अधिग्रहित भूमि का हिस्सा है, जो राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली सरकार द्वारा दिनांक 24-अधिसूचना द्वारा "मन क्षेत्र" भीषित किया गया है।

2. दिल्ली क्षेत्र का कटौत 864 हैक्टर "मन रिज" नामक हिस्से का रखरखाव, फिलहाल भारत सरकार के केंद्रीय लोक निर्माण विभाग है।

3. दिल्ली रिज क्षेत्र की सुरक्षा को लेकर दायर रिट याचिका संख्या 4677/1985 में भारत के माननीय उच्चतम न्यायालय के दिए अनुसार में राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली सरकार इस बात पर सहमत हुई है कि दोष अधिनियम में मन रिज की समुचित सुरक्षा सुनिश्चित व दिल्ली सरकार इस भूमि के रखरखाव और सुरक्षा का दायित्व अपने मन विभाग के माध्यम से अपने हाथ में लेंगी। यह भी सहमति हुई है कि "मन रिज" की सुरक्षा और रखरखाव के लिए राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली सरकार समुचित उपचार करेंगी।

4. अतः अब भारत सरकार करीब 864 हैक्टर आकार की "मन रिज" नामक नगल भूमि (जिसकी सीमा-रेखाओं को नीचे अधिसूचना में दर्शाया गया है) को "जैस है, जहां है" आधार पर तत्काल प्रभाव से राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली सरकार को सौंपती है ताकि वह रखरखाव "हरित क्षेत्र" के रूप में किया जा सके और माननीय उच्चतम न्यायालय द्वारा 3-1-1996 को पारित आदेश के अनुसार उक्त भूमि के लिये आवश्यकानुसार इस भूमि की सुरक्षा तथा रखरखाव के लिये बाड़ लगाने सहित समुचित उपचार किये जा सकें लेकिन उस होगा कि भूमि का स्वामित्व और पालिकाना हम भारत सरकार के पास हो रहेगा।

5. इसके अलावा राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र दिल्ली सरकार उक्त नगल भूमि पर कोई निर्माण नहीं करेगी अथवा करने देगी और जहां भी अभिमत हो उक्त भूमि भुचवा उसके किसी हिस्से को केन्द्र सरकार को सौंप देगी।

6. दिल्ली सरकार के साथ संयुक्त सर्वे के माध्यम से निर्धारित इस समय मौजूद अवैध कब्जों को हटाने की कार्यवाई राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र सरकार द्वारा केंद्रीय लोक निर्माण विभाग और भूमि तथा विकास कार्यालय के सहयोग से तत्काल शुरु की जायेगी।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 19th May, 2004

S.O. 410(E).— Whereas the land known as "Delhi Ridge area" forming part of the land acquired by the Government of India for the purpose of establishment of the New Capital of India at Delhi vide notification No. 775 dated 21-12-1911 has been notified by the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi as Forest area vide notification dated 24-5-94.

2. A part of the Delhi Ridge area known as "Central Ridge" measuring about 864 hectares is presently being managed by Central Public Works Deptt. Govt. of India.

3. Pursuant to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. 4677/1985 regarding protection of the Delhi Ridge area, it has been agreed by the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) that the responsibility of maintenance and protection of the Central Ridge, would be taken over by them through its forest department to ensure proper protection of this land in the long term. It has also been agreed that GNCTD would take appropriate measures for protection and maintenance of the "Central Ridge".

4. Now, therefore, the Govt. of India hereby places with immediate effect the nanal lands known as "Central Ridge" measuring about 864 hectares (having boundaries shown in the schedule given below) at the disposal of GNCTD on "as is where is" basis for maintenance of the said land as "Green" and for taking such appropriate measures including fencing for protection and maintenance of this land as may be required to serve the said purpose in accordance with the order dated 3-1-1996 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, subject to the condition that the ownership and title of the land shall continue to be vested with the Govt. of India.

5. Further, the GNCTD shall not make, or cause or permit to be made, any construction on the above said nanal lands and shall when required by the Govt. of India so to do, replace the said land or any portion thereof as may be so required, at the disposal of the Central Govt.

6. Action for removal of presently existing unauthorized occupation as identified through joint survey along with GNCTD, shall be initiated by GNCTD immediately in collaboration with CPWD and L&DO.


OFFICE ORDER






